-- To accommodate the expected demand, some courses will be offered in more than one time slot.

-- This is the chance to get all of your volunteers trained - please be sure to take advantage of it and communicate with them about this opportunity.

-- Pre-registration in eAYSO for all courses is <u>required</u>. Please make sure your volunteers know that and register. The courses are, or will be shortly, listed and registration is, currently available in eAYSO.

-- Costs for attendees from Regions in Areas A or D will be billed to the attendee's home Region after the Road Show. All others will need to pay at the door (cash or check payable to AYSO Area 6D). We will apportion the total costs of the event among the Regions sending attendees in an equitable manner based on number of courses attended, length of course, food (if all day course), etc. It is difficult to estimate costs, but based on past Area D Road Shows, cost per attendee ran in the range of \$20 - \$60 depending on the foregoing factors, but again, past performance is no guarantee of future results (and attendees from Regions not in Area A or D should be prepared to pay approximately that amount; receipts will be given so they can be reimbursed from their home Region).
